Materials and Equipment List:

Required

- 2 or 3 Inspirational source photos or pictures of your own 'Perfect Summer Day'
- A variety of coloured scraps of coloured cotton fabrics from your stash in tones and colours to match those in your source photo (for the finished project and sampling)
- Various embroidery threads (stranded cottons, Perlé cottons, crewel wool, etc.) to match those in your source photo (for the finished project and sampling)
- Decorative and sheer fabrics (the sheer fabric gift bags are ideal) from your stash for the main project and for learning and sampling techniques
- One piece of medium weight calico measuring about 35cm x 35cm (for the main project)
- A few pieces medium weight calico measuring about 30cm x 30cm (for sampling stitches and techniques)
- Sketch book or A4 paper
- HB pencil
- Colouring art pencils
- Pencil sharpener and eraser
- Ruler & set square
- Fine-line pen permanent black ink
- Tracing paper (several A4 sheets)
- Thin quilt wadding
- Craft felt
- Lightweight polyester stuffing
- Polyester sewing thread in various colours
- A reel of clear invisible thread
- Fine long pins
- Chalk fabric pencil or dissolving fabric marker
- Basic sewing Kit which should include fine embroidery needles, thimble, tweezers, sharp pointed embroidery scissors, paper scissors and fabric scissors
- PVA or clear drying water-based adhesive

Optional

- Scraps of 1.6mm thick card
- One piece of plain coloured medium weight fabric for the background of main project measuring about 35cm x 35cm
- Light box (iPad can be used)
- Bond-a-web
- Fabric marking coloured pencils such as Derwent Intense, or fabric paints
